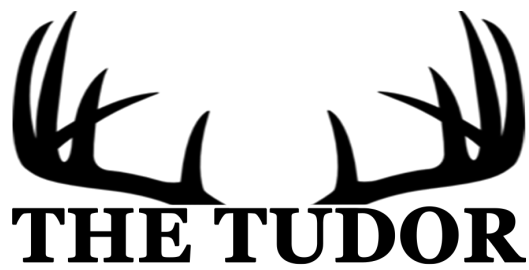

Drappier Champagne, founded in 1808, combines forward-thinking innovation with deep historic roots. This family-run house, set in 12th-century cellars built by Cistercian monks, revived Pinot Noir in the Aube in the 1930s and pioneered Champagne's first rosé in a clear bottle. Known for minimal sulphur use and unique practices—such as fermenting each bottle size individually, from half-bottles to the massive 30L Melchisedech—Drappier crafts wines of elegance, concentration, and finesse.
